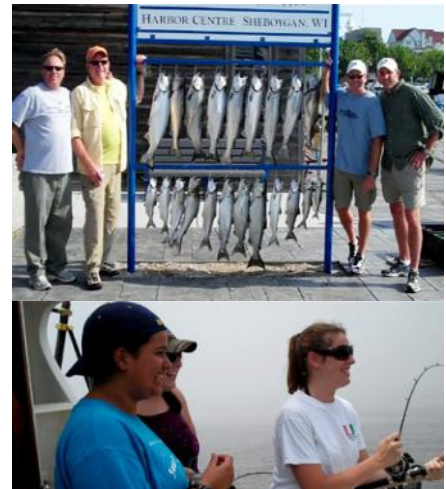

## Presidents Report

---

Hello Club Members:

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all the speakers we had at our club meetings during this past winter season. In February, Russ Gahagan of Angler's Avenue was our speaker. Russ gave a presentation on flashers, since that is his favorite method of fishing. Russ recommends silver flashers for sunny, bright days in the upper column, green with glow for deeper depths, white for mid-depths, and UV flashers for shallow depths. There are no specific rules, only these guidelines, since we all know that every day the conditions change, so your fishing techniques have to change as well. Russ also likes to run one big 11" flasher deep and close to the bottom. He also recommends running longer leads between flashers and flies of 28" to 32". With 8" flashers, Russ starts his leads at 23". He prefers a slow troll of 1.9 to 2.1 because he feels big fish are lazy. Russ targets plugs for harbor fishing, and stated that spoons have their time and place and prefers Stingers, Moonshines and Pro-kings. Magnum Walker divers on a wire line is his hot ticket, with the inside set at one and the outside diver set at three for when the kings go deep. Copper wire on boards is also hot when fish go deeper than 100 feet. In February, we also had Cheryl Masterson, Lake Michigan Fisheries Technician, to introduce herself to our club and she offered to get more information on the stocking and planting of fish for our club. It is great to have Cheryl on board. Jeff Brown was our speaker in March, giving a presentation on hot coho set ups. As we all know, Jeff is a tackle manufacturer and gets good advice and information from many charter captains. Jeff recommends red and orange flashers for cohos, with red being his favorite. Tape is available to easily update your flashers with the hot colors. Jeff also mentioned that there is a 4-colored fly available at The Wharf that works because if the fish don't like blue, they will see the other colors and bite it. Jeff suggests that short leads between the fly and flasher work the best. The lead should be twice the flasher length. Faster troller speeds of 2.2 and up is a good starting point. Jeff also spoke about new UV tape and spoons that are out, with the UV tape working better than the UV paint. In March we had Steven Klock, giving us the latest information on the situation with the invasive species. Steve will be in charge of trying to help control the invasive species being transported from the Great Lakes to inland waters. Our May meeting will be held at The Wharf for our annual "Ride-A-Charter Boat" event. Please come and help, or stop by to see what our club gives back to the community. As always the kids and parents will be smiling from ear-to-ear during their boat rides. Finally, on a more somber note, we lost a long-time member of our club. Lyle Peschke passed away on Sunday, April 8th, after his long and courageous battle with cancer. As you all know, Lyle was the President of our club from the year 2000 to 2008, and served our club with honor and pride. Our deepest sympathies are extended to his wife, Jennifer, who is a hard-working member of our club as well.

About a dozen of our club members volunteered at various times throughout the day to teach kids to cast, tie knots, identify and clean fish. Fish printing was also provided by park volunteers. All kids that participated received a plaque of accomplishment from the park staff. The park did not know what to expect since this was the first event held at the brand new fishing pond just built last year. It was a great day weather wise considering the forecast and there was a good steady turnout. Our club contributed \$2000 last year for the construction of this pond, and it was money well spent.



When fishing out of the Port of Sheboygan, be aware of the current locations of the commercial whitefish trap nets.

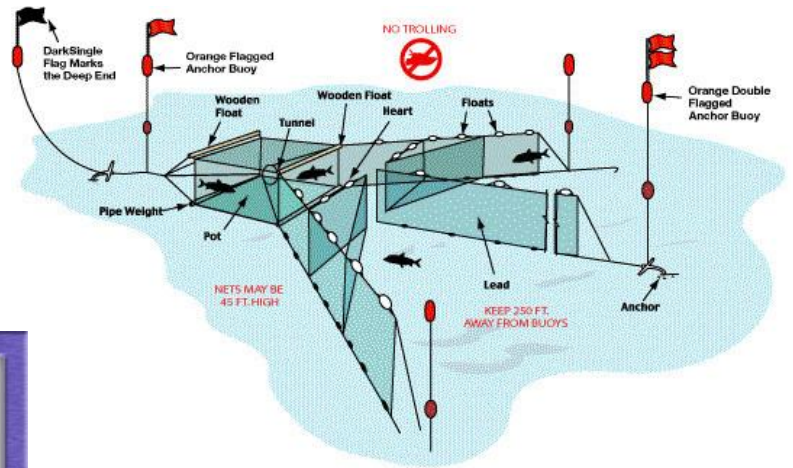
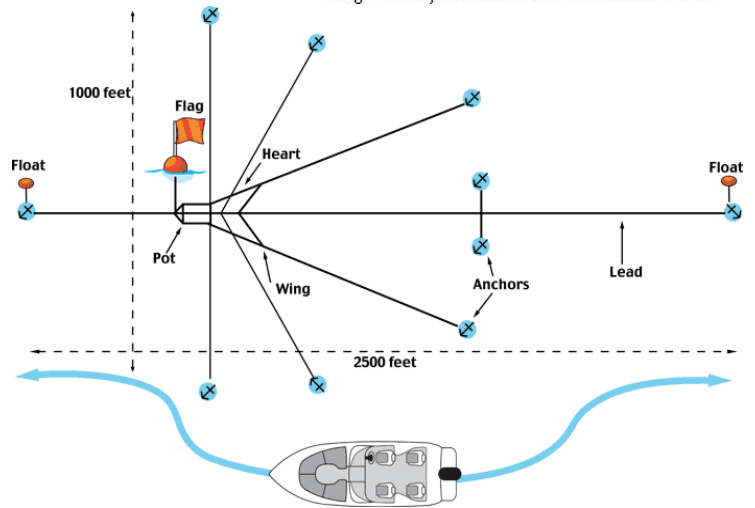
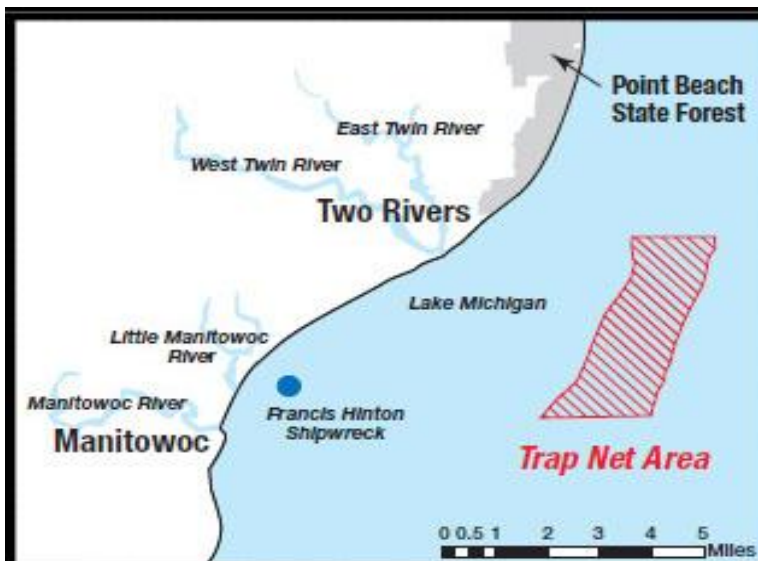

Last year our club donated \$1500 for a custom made device that oxygenates the water. This new device was just put in operation during the end of the season and was put to the test. Hatchery supervisor Andy Hron attended our April meeting with an update. He explained this new device allows him to raise more fish in the holding tanks which in turn can produce more rainbow trout for our fishery. After testing the unit and proving it's success, he would like to purchase another unit for this year. He is asking if our club would donate another \$1500 this year for an additional unit. We decided to take this under consideration and make a decision at our June meeting.

## Junior Coho Derby Date Set for June 23, 2012. Sign up Now
